

Mothers Matter Centre Announces 2020 A Vision for the Inclusion of Isolated Mothers in Canada Conference to take place from May 5-7, 2020 at Harbour Centre in Vancouver, B.C.

Vancouver, December 3rd, 2019 – The Mothers Matter Centre will host a conference in May 2020 with the goal of amplifying the voices of mothers who have overcome barriers to inclusion, and exploring the means of unleashing the power of isolated low-income mothers as a force for social, economic, and political change. The program will feature the stories of mothers sharing their journeys as agents of change. It will also highlight the expertise of contemporary researchers, policy-makers, and community practitioners who specialize in gender equality and family wellbeing. There will be four panels relating to topics of:

- 1) Education and leadership development;
- 2) Health, wellness, and safety;
- 3) Economic security; and,
- 4) Social inclusion.
